Dear Mr England

If you received this letter for the second reason and intended to accept the changed course offer you must contact the university or college directly to ask whether or not they are willing to consider you again in Clearing.

Clearing

Clearing runs from mid-July until mid-September and gives applicants without a university or college place the opportunity to be considered at universities or colleges who still have vacancies. If you made only one choice and paid the reduced fee of £11, you will need to pay a further £11 before you can add a Clearing choice on Track.

We begin advertising Clearing vacancies on our website www.ucas.com on 16 August (early August for vacancies at Scottish universities), but you are free to contact universities and colleges before then. If you are waiting for examination results, you should wait until these results have been published before contacting universities and colleges.
