

# Application for admission to BOTH Route A (simultaneous) and Route B (sequential) courses in Art & Design

Use this flowchart if applying through Route A and Route B at the same time

## Route A (simultaneous)

**1 September 2008 – 15 January 2009**

Application completed with up to four Route A choices. Applicants opt to add at least one Route B Art & Design course later.

UCAS sends copy of Route A application to universities and colleges chosen.

Each university and college makes a decision on application.

Has applicant been offered a place?

### Late Applications

**16 January to 30 June 2009**

Applications received between these dates are **Late Applications**. Universities and colleges will consider them if they want to make more offers.

**30 June 2009**

Applications received after 30 June are entered in Clearing.

## Route B (sequential)

**1 September 2008 – 24 March 2009**

Applicants use Track at [www.ucas.com](http://www.ucas.com) to add up to three Route B choices and, if necessary, revise personal statements. Applicants can no longer provide a revised reference for Route B choices. Strong recommendation that applications reach UCAS by **6 March 2009**.

Recommended final date for receipt of Route B applications.

Last date for receipt of 'on time' Route B applications.

UCAS starts to send applications to first choice universities and colleges

Has applicant been offered a Route B place?

UCAS starts to send applications to second choice universities and colleges

Has applicant been offered a Route B place?

UCAS starts to send applications to third choice universities and colleges

Has applicant been offered a Route B place?

Has applicant been offered a Route A place?

### Late Applications

**25 March to 11 June 2009**

Applications received between these dates are **Late Applications**. Universities and colleges will consider them if they want to make more offers.

**Late Applications** will be sent in the first available round.

**11 June 2009**

Applications received after 11 June are entered in Clearing.

Does applicant want to accept place? (Can hold offer if still awaiting decisions on Route A applications.)

Unconditional offer.

**APPLICANT ACCEPTED**

Firm acceptance commits applicant to this university or college.

**EXTRA**

If applicant has used all five choices and is holding no offers, another choice can be made through Extra.

**CLEARING**

If applicant has used all five choices and is holding no offers, another choice can be made through Extra.

If applicant achieves better grades than required for their firmly accepted offer, they may look for an alternative course that has places available whilst still holding their original choice. Full details of the process will be available closer to the time.
