Accidents and near misses

If you are involved in, or witness an accident or near miss while on-site, please report it to the general information desk immediately.

Arrivals

On arrival, please head to the Sir Stanley Matthews Sports Hall. Please have your ticket ready for inspection. If you don't have a ticket on arrival, please report to the registration desk at the Sir Stanley Matthews Sports Centre.

Your exhibition ticket is personal to you and should not be passed on to other group members as this would compromise the security of your data.

To comply with data protection regulations, it's essential that individuals at our exhibitions use their own ticket – both on entering, and when visiting exhibitors stands. Anyone found to be in breach of this will be asked to leave the event and re-register to gain re-admittance.

Cars

Parking will be very limited on the day, therefore we strongly encourage visitors to use public transport.

For information about getting to the university by train, please visit the university's <u>website</u>. Stoke-on-Trent railway station is a five-minute walk from the Sir Stanley Matthews Sports Centre.

Cash machines

There is a cash machine on campus, however the machine is the responsibility of the bank and not Staffordshire University – therefore, we cannot guarantee this will be available on the day.

Catering

There will be refreshments available for visitors to purchase in the Catalyst Kitchen, Catalyst Café and the Student's Union Shop.

Coaches

On arrival, event staff will direct coaches to car park 5 to drop students off. Your coach driver will then turn around and head back to car park 1, where they will be located for the duration of their stay. Please ask your coach company to print off the parking pass at the end of his pack and display it in the windscreen of the coach at all times.

Once your students have exited the coach, please direct them to the entrance of the Sir Stanley Matthews Sports Centre, where they will be met by staff dressed in UCAS t-shirts. As this is a working day, please encourage your students to use pavements and pedestrian crossings, as traffic will be moving around campus.

Emergency procedures

Please ensure you're familiar with the procedures to be followed in the event of an emergency at the venue. In the event of an emergency, please make your way to the nearest exit immediately. Do not use lifts.

Assemble in the nearest car park well away from the building. Wheelchair users, other than on ground floor locations, should in the first instance be assisted or directed to a refuge point (usually a protected lobby or stairwell).

Event Staff

For any general queries during the event (e.g. directions to facilities), ask any of the event staff, who can be identified by their UCAS t-shirts.

First aid

If you sustain any personal injuries, or are present when an accident happens, please ask for assistance from the organisers.

If you feel unwell during your visit, please contact a member of event staff, who will call the nominated first aider for this event. All accidents, no matter how trivial, must be reported on a university accident report form (please request a form from a member of staff).

Insurance

The organiser has adequate public and employee liability cover. A copy of the certificate can be found at the back of this pack.

While the organisers take every precaution to protect visitor's property during an event, they are not responsible for any loss or damage. All group leaders should ensure they have adequate public and employers' liability cover, in line with the booking terms and conditions.

To access the free Wi-Fi on campus, you will need to connect to the 'Wi-Fi Guest' network. When you open an internet window, you will be asked to complete a short registration form. Once registered, you will have unlimited access to the internet.
