Accidents and near misses

If you are involved in or witness an accident or near miss while on-site, please report it to the organiser's office immediately, located at the front of the hall.

Accessibility

Full details on accessibility can be found on the Exhibition Centre Liverpool website.

Arrival

On arrival, please head to the main entrance of Exhibition Centre Liverpool – you will see the UCAS flags. Please have your ticket ready for inspection. If you don't have a ticket, please report to the registration desk inside the hall entrance.

Your exhibition ticket is personal to you and should not be passed on to other group members, as this could compromise the security of your data.

To comply with data protection regulations, it's essential that individuals at our exhibitions use their own ticket – both on entering, and when visiting exhibitors' stands. Anyone found to be in breach of this will be asked to leave the event and register again to be readmitted.

Please be aware, we will be conducting random bag searches upon entry.

Car parking

Visitors can easily reach Exhibition Centre Liverpool by car. Full directions can be found on the venue website at www.accliverpool.com/organising-an-event/travelling-here.

Parking is available nearby, with various car parking facilities. Parking charges do apply. Further details about parking can be found at the back of this pack.



Catering

Catering will be available during the event. Hot and cold food and drink will be available, although this area may be busy at times, due to the number of visitors attending. The venue only accepts card payments.

Cloakroom

There are no cloakroom facilities at this event.

Coaches

If you're travelling by coach, there is a designated drop-off and pick-up area located on the water side of the Exhibition Centre Liverpool. Traffic marshals will direct your coach driver and tell you when to disembark. If you have informed UCAS you will be travelling by coach, a coach pass will be emailed to you before the event to display.

When you're ready to leave the exhibition, please make sure all your students are together and proceed along the walkway, back to the coach pick-up point. The traffic marshals will ensure your coach is ready. Due to the large number of coaches and small space available, it is essential the traffic marshals' instructions are followed at all times.

Covid-19 Precautions

Face coverings

We highly recommend that you wear a face covering inside the venue and the hall unless you are exempt. We will have a provision of these at the registration area but advise that you bring your own.

Social distancing

We will be promoting a recommended social distancing of 1m+ within the public areas in the venue and our event hall.

Self-scan for tickets and onsite registration

This year we will be operating a self-scan service to gain entry into the event hall. Support will be available for this service if required.

Cleaning

Liverpool will be regularly cleaning high traffic and touchpoint areas throughout the event.

From the North - Leave the M6 at junction 26 and follow signs for M58 Liverpool. Follow to end of M58 and then take signs for A59 Liverpool. Continue to follow Liverpool City Centre until picking up signs for Arena & Convention Centre Liverpool.

From the South - Leave the M6 at junction 21A and take the M62 to Liverpool. At the end of the M62 follow signs for Liverpool City Centre along Edge Lane, picking up and following signs for Arena & Convention Centre Liverpool.


