GETTING HERE



The exhibition is being held at the University of Worcester Arena. Entrance to the Arena is off Hylton Road, Worcester. The postcode for the venue is WR2 5JN.

TRAVELLING BY CAR OR COACH?

Due to construction works taking place at the Arena there will be no availability for coaches to park at the Arena, free coach parking will be available at our Lakeside Campus, WR6 6NH.


If you're travelling by coach, there is a designated drop-off and pick-up area located at the Arena. Please follow the directions of the traffic marshals on arrival.

Traffic marshals will direct your coach driver and tell you when to disembark.

When you are ready to leave the exhibition, please ensure all your students are together and proceed to the coach pick-up point. Due to the large number of coaches and the small space available, it is essential to always follow the traffic marshals' instructions.

WHEN YOU ARRIVE

On arrival, please head to the University of Worcester Arena main entrance. Please have your ticket ready for inspection. If you don't have a ticket on arrival, please report to the registration desk at the main entrance.

Your exhibition ticket is personal to you and should not be passed on to other group members, as this could compromise the security of your data. To comply with data protection regulations, it's essential that individuals at our exhibitions use their own ticket – both on entering, and when visiting exhibitors' stands. Anyone found to be in breach of this will be asked to leave the event and register again to be readmitted.

The time slot you have chosen on the on-line booking system is your time of entry to the exhibition. For health and safety reasons, entry to the exhibition will not be permitted until your allocated time slot is reached.
