




#### AN INTRODUCTION TO UCAS

As a highly trusted, independent charity, UCAS helps over 700,000 people from more than 200 countries and territories to explore the opportunities and benefits of undergraduate higher education (HE) every year. We are proud to enable over half a million people to change their lives by embarking on their studies at a UK university or college. Our digital capability and customer service expertise also mean that we can support individuals interested in exploring postgraduate courses, as well as degree and higher apprenticeships, and we currently run admissions services for conservatoires, postgraduate courses, and teacher training.

UCAS has a turnover of circa £50m. About 40% of that revenue comes from income generated from commercial activity through subsidiaries – all of which is gift aided back into the charity. The charity generates the remaining 60% of income through the application fees paid by individuals, and a fee paid by universities and colleges for students placed.

The Digital and Data team defines and delivers the digital products and services used by students, providers, advisers, and commercial partners, as well as the underlying technology platforms that enable these products to be developed in a responsive and agile way. Our new digital strategy, 'Connected and flexible admissions services for the digital age', sets out our intention for UCAS to be a customer centric, product-focused digital business, able to use data and digital technologies to connect students with their next opportunity, and to connect providers of further and higher education with individuals with whom they can build lasting, empowering possibilities.


