TRAVELLING BY CAR OR COACH?

Coaches.

Schools/Colleges will be sent a colour coded coach permit for their allocated time slot. There is NO Coach parking on site, coaches need to make their way to South Winchester Park and Ride or Worthy Lane Coach Park.

ACCIDENTS & NEAR MISSES


If you are involved in, or witness an accident or near miss while on-site, please report it. Contact the nearest member of staff.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

- **WHAT INSURANCE IS IN PLACE FOR THE EVENT?**

The organiser has adequate public and employee liability cover. While the organisers take every precaution to protect visitor's property during an event, they are not responsible for any loss or damage. All group leaders should ensure they have adequate public and employers' liability cover, in line with the booking terms and conditions.

- **WHAT HAPPENS TO ANY LOST PROPERTY?**
