UCAS 2015 admissions changes

Release 2 – completed in September 2014

As part of the ongoing work to prepare our systems for the 2015 admissions cycle, we are planning to make the second release of the 2015 admissions changes live on Monday 8 September 2014.

In the interim, the Release 2 data and changes have been made available on the HEP test environment since 1 September for you to be able to test changes you have made to your systems.
