Key feedback

- > Students commented that the Hub interface looks user friendly, accessible and purposeful.
- > Students would value apprenticeship opportunities to be displayed, alongside undergraduate courses, after completing the Careers Quiz.
- > Advisers really valued the Accommodation best practice guidance which was produced in conjunction with the Adviser Advisory Group and Provider Advisory Group.
- > Many advisers felt that having a soft ECD time at 15.00 would not help them as many advisers were still teaching at this time and so less support would be available.
- > HE Marketing Services Advisory Group suggested changing the name 'Decision Trees' to 'Competitor Insight dashboard'.
- > The Qualifications Advisory Group gave their Initial feedback on the suggestions to change the Tariff Tables.
