


WHILST YOU'RE HERE

WHEN YOU ARRIVE

On arrival, head to the **Sports Academy reception** and have your ticket ready for inspection. If you don't have a ticket on arrival, please report to the registration desk **at the Sports Academy reception**.

Your exhibition ticket is personal to you and should not be passed on to other group members, as this could compromise the security of your data. To comply with data protection regulations, it's essential that individuals at our exhibitions use their own ticket – both on entering, and when visiting exhibitors' stands. Anyone found to be in breach of this will be asked to leave the event and register again to be readmitted.

If you are involved in, or witness an accident or near miss while on-site, please report it to the **Exhibitor Help Desk** located in the exhibition hall.



WHAT INSURANCE IS IN PLACE FOR THE EVENT?
