I have not repeated any information, evidence or examples across the three answers. Remember that the personal statement is viewed as a whole.	

## READ AND REVIEW

Now it is over to someone you trust. Remember when asking someone to review your work you need feedback that is constructive and actionable.

Ask for specific comments on how you can improve your personal statement. Ask for feedback that directs you to where improvements are needed, for example 'your paragraph about...did not include enough evidence of how you... could you add some more...'
