# **EVENT INFORMATION**

#### **ACCESSIBILITY:**

Blue badge parking is available on campus in designated bays without a permit. The event will be ramp accessible via the side of the building What3words: ///manual.juices.grain. Our campus access guides for all buildings can be found here:

Prayer facilities are available in the multi-faith chaplaincy located on the opposite side of the quad on the High Street. Exhibitors are also welcome to use this as a quiet space away from the event. An exhibitor and staff lounge will also be available in the Far Linklater Room.

## **ACCOMMODATION**

Please note, there are lots of hotels located in Aberdeen City Centre or in Dyce. There is regular direct transport links from Aberdeen City Centre to King Street which is a couple of minutes walk from the venue.

As the event "Offshore Europe" is taking place this week, hotels in Aberdeen will book up quickly so we recommend you book early!

### **CAR PARKING**

Exhibitors can park on Campus by displaying the UCAS Aberdeen parking permit on their dashboard. We would recommend parking in one of the car parks located off King Street or the Car Park next to the Arches at the bottom of Dunbar Street. More information on page 6.

### **CATERING**

Tea and Coffee will be available in the Far Linklater room for exhibitors. There are also shops and food outlets located on the High Street across the Quad from the venue. ## **SCANNING**

To take advantage of lead scanning at this event, you need to download the Smartlead UCAS and have purchased scanning for the UCAS Discovery events. You will need a license code per device per event which are assigned to you when you purchase the scanning. Make sure your staff at the event have been provided with the license codes.

You will find a guide to setting up your device and how to manage your data in the <u>Exhibitor zone</u> along with a Scanning Instructions document that you can share with your staff attending the event. Hard copies are also provided on your stand.

## **BUILD & BREAKDOWN**

Exhibitors may park in any of the car parks off King Street What3words (///clock.curvy.zips) or in the car park on Dunbar Street next to the arches What3words (///bound.feed.region). Both are a very short walk to the venue. **Please display your UCAS parking pass when parking**.

Contractors may park in the small car park behind the venue. This is accessed from Regent Walk through the black gates next to the playing fields What3words (///stay.dull.cars). There is ramped access into the building from Regent Walk for trolleys.

If arriving on the 2nd to set up, contractors/exhibitors may temporarily park in front of Elph Hall to unload What3words (///glare.trails.linked) however, this road will be shut at 8.30am on the 3rd in preparation for the event and after this, parking will only be in designated carparks.
