

TRAVELLING BY CAR OR COACH?

Directions - From the East, South or West, take the M9 to Junction 11. At the junction, there is a roundabout which marks the end of the M9. From here you should take the exit for Bridge of Allan, follow the road through the town itself, and after about 200 metres you will find the University entrance on the left. From the North, take the A9 to the same roundabout and follow the same route through Bridge of Allan as above.

Car Parking – Cars should be parked at the South Car Park. This is to the south of the campus to the rear of The Stirling Court Hotel. There is a road to the east of the hotel leading to the South Car Park. Parking will be free of charge for up to two hours. Thereafter there is a parking tariff in place.

Coach Drop-off/Pick-up and Parking — Coaches should use the Bus Hub for drop off. After drop off, if coaches are to remain on campus, they should be parked in the visitor's lane at the main entrance booth. Coaches should then return to the Bus Hub for pick-up. Buses/coaches are automatically exempt from the parking charges.
