EVENT INFORMATION

CATERING

There are no public catering facilities at the event. There is a sink/small kitchenette available for exhibitors to re-fill water bottles. Please bring your own refillable bottle.

FIRST AID

If you have a medical emergency or require any first aid during the build-up, event, or breakdown, please visit alert a member of venue staff who can call for assistance.

INTERNET

Free wi-fi is available at the venue. Log-in details will be available in the hall.

SCANNING

To take advantage of lead scanning at this event, you need to download the Smartlead UCAS and have purchased scanning for the UCAS/Discovery events. You will need a licence code per device per event which are assigned to you when you purchase the scanning. Make sureyour staff at the event have been provided with the licence codes. You will find a guide to setting up your device and how to manage your datain the Exhibitor zone here, along with a Scanning Instructions document that you can share with your staff attending the event. RISK ASSESSMENTS

All exhibitors need to provide a risk assessment for your stand build and any activities that will be happening on your stand. Please send this through to Chloe Lemon c.lemon@ucas.ac.uk least 4 weeks before the exhibition date. The event organiser has completed a risk assessment for the event.



VEHICLE ACCESS

Please note, the Town Hall building is within a pedestrian zone. Vehicle access between 10:30-18:00 is restricted to permit holders only.
