

COLLECT HEP3 FAMILIARISATION

To support your preparation for launch of UCAS Collect in January 2026 we have released a new version of UCAS Collect into our test and training environment (HEP3).

In this latest UCAS Collect update, your 2026/27 courses data from the Collection Tool has been used to create a 2027/28 version, migrated into the new course structure. This allows you to preview how your course data will transition when the new structure goes live.

There will be some preparatory work that you will need to do to your courses when we go live with UCAS Collect, but we hope that by giving you the opportunity to really explore the new tool in our training environment, it will make the transition and readiness activities easier in the new tool.

We encourage you to spend some time familiarising yourself with UCAS Collect in HEP3.

FAMILIARISATION ACTIVITIES IN HEP3

Explore and check the data in Provider Management

- We have migrated over your existing data, take a look and check it's as you would expect.
- Have a look and explore the new sections available and how you create and manage your reference data.

Explore and check the data in Course Management

- We have migrated over your existing courses data, take a look and check it is as you would expect, does anything look strange or unexpected?
- Explore the different sections.
