GETTING HERE





Travelling by car or coach?

Farnborough International is located just off the A325, accessible from the M3 (J4) and A31. For this event, please enter via Gate F and follow directions from traffic marshals.



Where can I park my car?

Once on site, follow signs and directions from traffic marshal to Car Park 1. Parking is free of charge.

Where can I park a coach or minibus?

Once on site, follow signs and directions from traffic marshal to Car Park 1. Coach parking is free of charge however coaches will need to display a permit for your session time in the window. A permit will be supplied via email 1-2 weeks prior to the event.



Travelling by Train?

Farnborough International Exhibition & Conference Centre can be accessed via four train stations: Farnborough Main, Farnborough North, North Camp and Aldershot. Farnborough Main in served by Southwest Trains and sits on the mainline to London Waterloo. This station is 1.5 miles from the venue, 5 minutes by taxi. Farnborough North and North Camp are served by First Great Western and are a 10-minute taxi ride from the venue. Aldershot is served by Southwest Trains and offers direct services to London Waterloo and Guildford. The Station is a 10-minute taxi ride from the venue. 


When you arrive

On arrival, please head to the main entrance (What 3 Words: ///mount.full.agrees). Every group member will need to have pre-registered before entering the venue and have their ticket ready to scan. If you have issues with a damaged phone screen, please bring a printed copy of your ticket. For those without a ticket, please report to the onsite registration desk that is located inside the entrance

Your exhibition ticket is personal to you and should not be passed on to other group members, as this could compromise the security of your data. To comply with data protection regulations, it's essential that individuals at our exhibitions use their own ticket – both on entering, and when visiting exhibitors' stands. Anyone found to be in breach of this will be asked to leave the event and register again to be readmitted.

ACCIDENTS & NEAR MISSES


If you are involved in, or witness an accident or near miss while on-site, please report it to the organiser's office immediately.

• Is there anywhere I can store my coat and bags?
