

SUPPORTING LEARNERS ADDING T LEVELS TO THEIR APPLICATION

From the 2026 cycle onwards, UCAS added all T Level pathways individually, allowing students to search for and enter a single T Level qualification on their UCAS application. These now appear in the application as shown below:

T Level Technical Qualification Building Services Engineering for Construction

We recommend that you review your centre's qualification shortlist and if T levels are included that you update these to the specific T level pathways that you offer, rather than the four parts which was the previous structure available.

2027 application cycle changes

In response to feedback and other observed issues, including missing components (core, specialism, industry placement) and mismatched grades assigned to components, we've made further improvements to how students add their T levels in the application:

- Guidance text has been added to help applicants to add the correct information.
- We have made the addition of components mandatory, making only the three component parts available for selection, and removing the use of 'Level', helping applicants to understand exactly what needs to be entered.

- Grades are now displayed alongside their component names (e.g. Core-grade, Specialism-grade) to help applicants identify the correct ones, and
- We have also removed the requirements for 'Level' to be added.

How do students add T level Core, Specialism and Placements?

Once the correct T level pathway has been selected, core, specialism and placement components should be added using the 'add another module' pill.

The relevant options will appear in the drop-down list once the student begins typing the component name and the relevant component grade can be added.
