GETTING HERE



Travelling by car or coach?

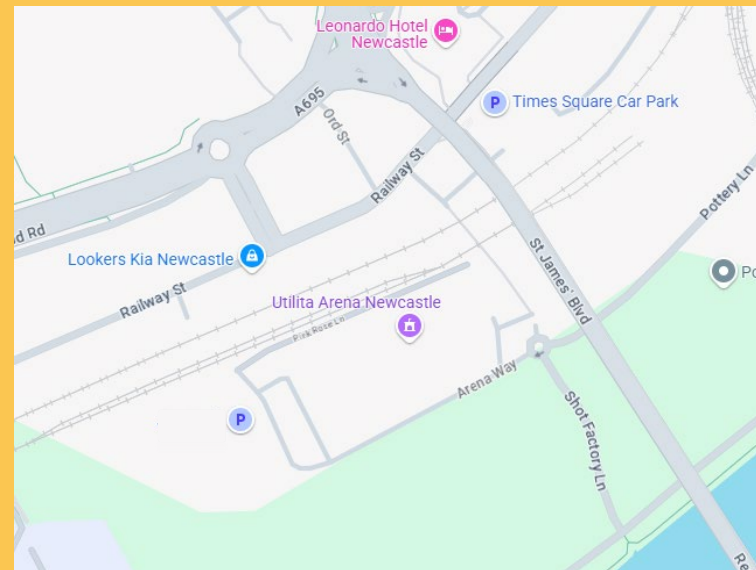
Utilita Arena Newcastle is 3 minutes from the A1 North - South route. Take the A184 signposted 'City Centre', follow the A189 over the Redheugh Bridge. When in the vicinity of the Arena, follow the signs to the venue.

If using satellite navigation, the full address is - Utilita Arena Newcastle, Arena Way, Newcastle upon Tyne, NE4 7NA. Visit the venue website for further travel information [here](#).



Where can I park my car?

Visitor parking is available at the rear of the venue, with over 600 official spaces supported by CCTV and regular security patrols. Although this is a public car park, parking charges will be suspended for our event and ANPR will not be in operation.

Where can I park a coach or minibus?

Coach passes will be sent to the group leader approximately one week before the exhibition and must be clearly displayed in the windscreen of the vehicle. On arrival, please follow the instructions of traffic marshals who will be on hand to guide you through the coach operation. There is a designated drop-off and pick-up area, located at the side of the venue, on Arena Way.

After groups have disembarked, coaches will be signposted to the onsite coach parking and may only return to the drop-off/collection area, once all members of the group are ready to board. Coaches will need to give their registration numbers to the traffic team on entering the coach parking.

For coach parking, please note that the venue car park is public; however, parking charges will be suspended and ANPR will not be in operation.



Travelling by Train?

Newcastle has direct rail connections to most major UK cities for easy access to the city centre. Newcastle Central Train Station (situated on Neville Street) is less than 15-minutes' walk from Utilita Arena, or just 6-minutes by taxi.

The venue has a partner taxi company, [Blueline Taxis](#) which have a drop-off and collection point opposite the main entrance.

When you arrive



On arrival, please head to the **main entrance of Utilita Arena**. Please have your ticket ready to scan into the event. Everyone will need to have pre-registered and have downloaded their ticket before they enter the venue. If you have issues with a cracked phone screen, please bring a printed copy of your ticket to be scanned.



Your exhibition ticket is personal to you and should not be passed on to other group members, as this could compromise the security of your data. To comply with data protection regulations, it's essential that individuals at our exhibitions use their own ticket – both on entering, and when visiting exhibitors' stands. Anyone found to be in breach of this will be asked to leave the event and register again to be readmitted.



Please be aware, the venue has walk-through metal detectors on entry and may be conducting random bag and wand searches. Please see the venue's Security & Luggage Guidance [here](#). We thank you for your patience while this takes place.

ACCIDENTS & NEAR MISSES

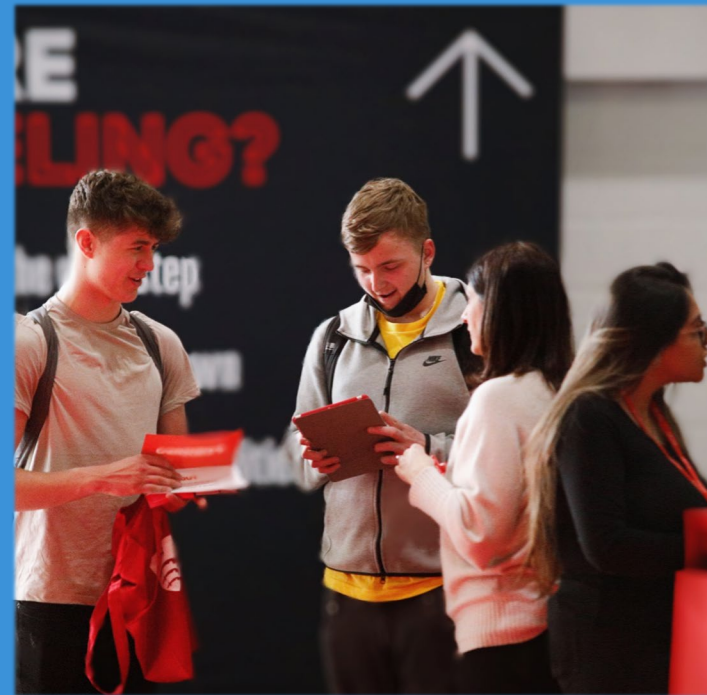
If you are involved in, or witness an accident or near miss while on-site, please alert a member of UCAS Events Team or a member of venue security.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

- **IS THERE ANYWHERE I CAN STORE MY COAT AND BAGS?**

There is no cloakroom service available at this event. Please see the venue bag policy [here](#), please only bring essential items and all bags must be smaller than 40cm x 35cm x 19cm which is approximately A3 size.

- **WHAT INSURANCE IS IN PLACE FOR THE EVENT?**

The organiser has adequate public and employee liability cover. While the organisers take every precaution to protect visitors' property during an event, they are not responsible for any loss or damage. All group leaders should ensure they have adequate public and employers' liability cover, in line with the booking terms and conditions.

- **WHAT HAPPENS TO ANY LOST PROPERTY?**

All property found in the hall and handed to the venue, will be kept for four weeks. After four weeks, if no claim in respect of that property has been made by any person, Utilita Arena reserves the right to donate the item to their designated charity.
