TRAVELLING BY CAR OR COACH?



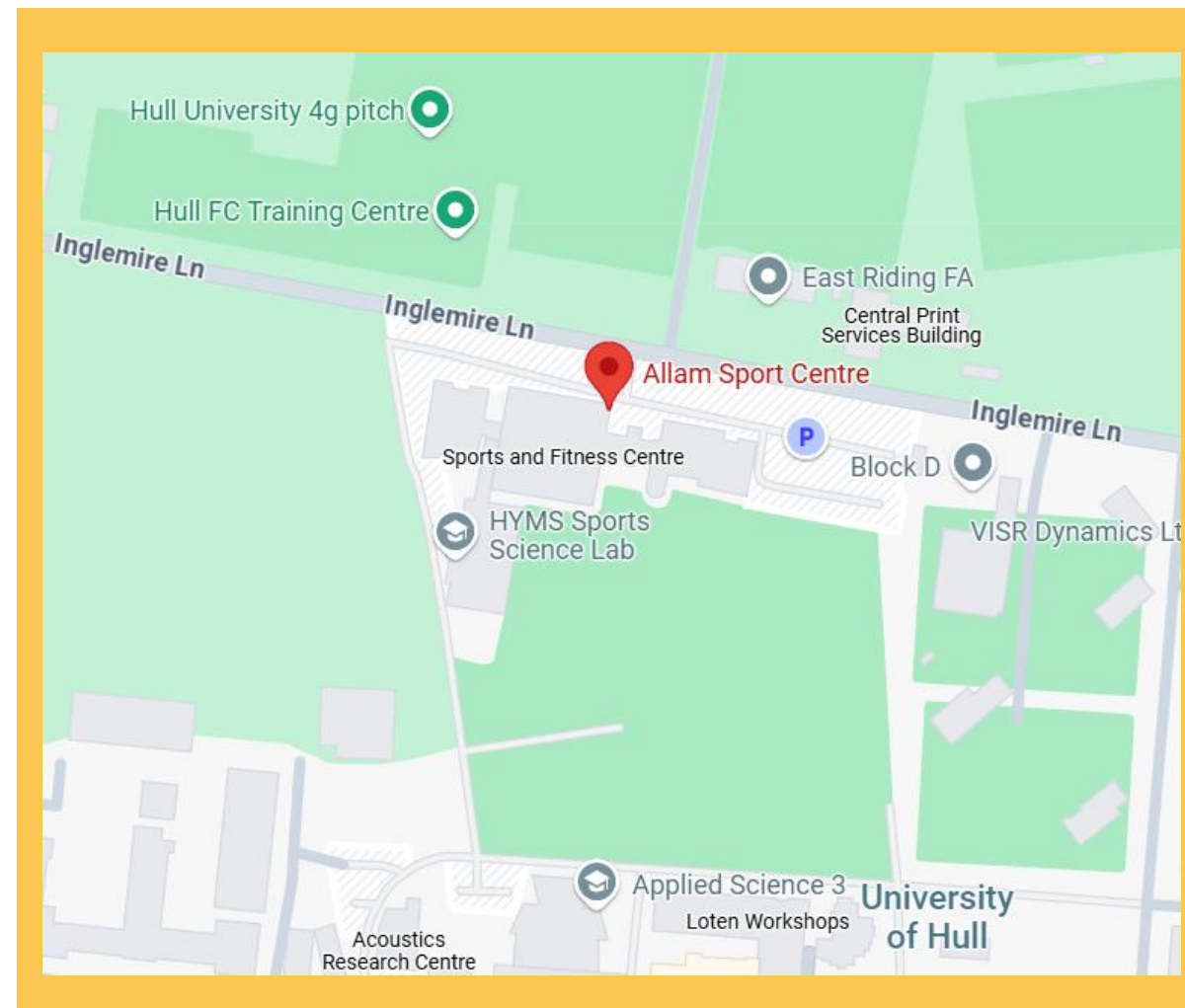

WHEN YOU ARRIVE



On arrival, please head to the **main entrance located at the Allam Sports Centre**. Please have your ticket ready for inspection. If you don't have a ticket on arrival, please report to the registration desk **please enter location of onsite registration**.



Your exhibition ticket is personal to you and should not be passed on to other group members, as this could compromise the security of your data. To comply with data protection regulations, it's essential that individuals at our exhibitions use their own ticket – both on entering, and when visiting exhibitors' stands. Anyone found to be in breach of this will be asked to leave the event and register again to be readmitted.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

- **WHAT INSURANCE IS IN PLACE FOR THE EVENT?**

The organiser has adequate public and employee liability cover. While the organisers take every precaution to protect visitors' property during an event, they are not responsible for any loss or damage. All group leaders should ensure they have adequate public and employers' liability cover, in line with the booking terms and conditions.

- **WHAT HAPPENS TO ANY LOST PROPERTY?**

All property found at the venue will be handed in to the Lost Property Department, and will be retained for six months. If, after six months, no claim in respect of that property has been made by any person, the venue shall consider that property has been abandoned and shall receive the rights to offer that property for sale. Should you find a lost item, please hand this in to event staff in the Allam Sports Centre.
