


HUMAN RESOURCE MANAGERS AND DIRECTORS

Human resource managers and directors plan, organise and direct the personnel, training and industrial relations policies of organisations, advise on resource allocation and utilisation problems, measure the effectiveness of an organisation's systems, methods and procedures and advise on, plan and implement procedures to improve utilisation of labour, equipment and materials.

Assess the affordability of their choice

Students should calculate their estimated maintenance loan **before** they pick their top 5 choices



Is there anything on their personal checklist that could come at an unexpected cost?

What is the cost of joining a club or society? Are there bursaries available?

Can they afford to commute to the university?

Does their funding cover additional requirements they may have, if not supported by the DSA?

Can they afford to park at the university, if they must drive?



Assess the affordability of their choice

Only 25% of students receive funding in the form of grants, bursaries and scholarships.

You can receive grants for being a vegetarian or even having the surname 'Graham', but much of this money goes untouched.
