GETTING HERE



Travelling by car or coach?


The campus is located on Perth Road, to the west of Dundee city centre. The University of Dundee can be accessed via the A90 from the North and West or the A92 from the east and south.

Where can I park my car?

Car parking is unavailable on University Campus, however the following public parking is suggested:

Where can I park a coach or minibus?

We request that coaches drop off on Old Hawkhill Road within the University Campus. What3words: ///wide.force.stiff Coach parking is not available onsite but coaches can wait a short time on this quiet road.



Travelling by public transport?

Dundee station is located to southwest of the city centre, approximately 0.6 miles from the campus. Dundee station is served by Scotrail, LNER and Caledonian Sleeper services, with connections to other major Scottish and UK cities.

Dundee station is a 12-minute walk to Bonar Hall or just 4-minutes by taxi.

Dundee Bus Station is to the east of the city centre. It is a 15-20 minute walk to the City Campus. The closest bus stop is Nethergate at University.

When you arrive

On arrival, please head to the **main entrance**, **located** on the **lower level of Bonar Hall**. Please have your ticket ready for inspection. If you don't have a ticket on arrival, please report to the registration desk.

Your exhibition ticket is personal to you and should not be passed on to other group members, as this could compromise the security of your data.
