
GETTING HERE

Travelling by car or coach?

For sat nav purposes, please use postcode S9 2DF. Alternatively, for directions from your own postcode, please visit the <u>venue website</u>

Where can I park my car?

There is free parking available on-site. Please follow the direction of the traffic marshals to the designated car park.



GETTING HERE

Where can I park a coach or minibus?

If you are travelling by coach or minibus, there is a designated car park area to park in that you will be directed to by traffic marshals on arrival. If coaches are dropping off only, they will be directed to a different location to drop off students and be directed off site. They can then return to the same area for collection later in the day. You will not need to display a coach pass as there is plenty of parking for coaches.

Travelling by public transport?

By Rail:

Sheffield's main railway station is situated in the City Centre - Sheaf Street, Sheffield, S1 2BP - and is approximately a 10 minute taxi ride.

Supertram:

The Arena has its very own stop - Arena / Olympic Legacy Park. This tram stop is served by the Yellow Route and Tram Train, both of which bypass the traffic giving you a fast, smooth and reliable way to get to your event. There's no need to buy a ticket before you get on board - there is a conductor on every tram.

Bus:

The Arena is served by several bus routes click here to visit the Travel South Yorkshire website. You can also view a full list of route maps for the whole region - just click here.


WHILST YOU'RE HERE

When you arrive

On arrival, please head up to the red concourse of Utilita Arena, or Entry B if you require accessible access. Please have your ticket ready to scan into the event. Everyone will need to have pre-registered and have downloaded their ticket before they enter the venue. If you have issues with a cracked phone screen, please bring a printed copy of your ticket to be scanned.

Your exhibition ticket is personal to you and should not be passed on to other group members, as this could compromise the security of your data. To comply with data protection regulations, it's essential that individuals at our exhibitions use their own ticket – both on entering, and when visiting exhibitors' stands. Anyone found to be in breach of this will be asked to leave the event and register again to be readmitted.

Please be aware, the venue will be conducting random bag and wand searches, we thank you for your patience while this takes place. The venues policy is that rucksacks/backpacks are not permitted and there is no on-site facility to store prohibited items. All bags larger than 30cm wide x 40cm long x 20cm deep (approx. A3 sized) are strictly prohibited. We advise you keep bags to a minimum or leave them on coaches where possible.

In both areas, a variety of items are available. Please note this venue only accepts card payments and is a cashless venue.

EVENT STAFF

For general queries during the event (e.g. directions to facilities), ask any of the event staff, who can be identified by their UCAS-branded t-shirts.

If you wish to speak to the event organisers, they will be based in the organiser's office, which located in the corridor behind the red tiered seating and will be signposted. A member of the Events Team will be in the office throughout the event.

ACCIDENTS & NEAR MISSES

EMERGENCY PROCEDURES

In the event of an evacuation, there will be an announcement over the arena's PA system. Should an evacuation of the building occur, please follow the instruction of the arena stewards, and leave the build via the nearest exit.

FIRST AID

There will be first aid cover throughout the open day of the exhibition, and the venue has a medical room staffed by qualified first aiders. Should you require medical assistance, please contact the organisers in the organiser's office.



FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS UCAS

Is there anywhere I can store my coat and bags?

Unfortunately, cloakrooms are not available for visitors at our events, we advise visitors to avoid bringing large bags and rucksacks into the event.

• What insurance is in place for the event?

The organiser has adequate public and employee liability cover. While the organisers take every precaution to protect visitors' property during an event, they are not responsible for any loss or damage. All group leaders should ensure they have adequate public and employers' liability cover, in line with the booking terms and conditions.

• What happens to any lost property?

All property found should be handed to the venue or the organiser's office, where it will be retained during the event, or until the owner claims it. If no owner is found for the duration of the event, the property will be left with the venue. Lost property will remain at the venue for approximately two months.

Can I smoke/vape on site?

Utilita Arena operates a strict no-smoking policy on-site and asks for your full cooperation in ensuring this is complied with.

• What security is there?
