Travelling by car or coach?

ICC Wales is just off junction 24 of the M4, and is clearly sign posted. The satnav postcode is NP18 1HQ.



Where can I park my car?

There is a carpark onsite with plenty of spaces available. Please note that parking charges below apply. Please follow the directions of the traffic marshals when you arrive. Please be aware the ICC Wales is a cashless venue.

Where can I park a coach or minibus?

Please follow the directions of the traffic marshals on arrival.

If you're travelling by coach, please enter the site through the main entrance, and traffic marshals will direct you to the coach drop-off and pick-up area. Once your students have departed, the coach will need to leave swiftly as there is no coach parking onsite. Coach passes will be sent out the week prior to the event. Please ensure this is displayed in the front windscreen whilst the coach is onsite, to assist the traffic team.

Due to the expected number of visitors, please don't arrive any earlier than 15 minutes before your booked session time.

Please ensure your students know what time and where to meet you for their return journey. When you're ready to leave the exhibition, please make sure all your students are together, and proceed back to the coach pick-up point. Due to the large number of coaches, it is essential the traffic marshals' instructions are followed at all times. If you are travelling by minibus, there will be a limited number of spaces for you to park and will be available on a first come first served basis. **Please follow the instructions of the onsite traffic marshals.**



Travelling by Train?

Newport train station is 4-6 miles from the venue, which is a 12-15-minute taxi trip. Please consider pre booking taxi's as necessary as there is not a taxi rank within walking distance of the venue.

When you arrive



On arrival, please head to the main entrance of the ICC Wales. Please have your ticket ready to scan into the event. Everyone will need to have pre-registered and have downloaded their ticket before they enter the venue. If you have issues with a cracked phone screen, please bring a printed copy of your ticket to be scanned.



Your exhibition ticket is personal to you and should not be passed on to other group members, as this could compromise the security of your data. To comply with data protection regulations, it's essential that individuals at our exhibitions use their own ticket – both on entering, and when visiting exhibitors' stands. Anyone found to be in breach of this will be asked to leave the event and register again to be readmitted.



Please be aware, the venue will be conducting random bag and wand searches. We thank you for your patience while this takes place. **Please do not bring any sharp items (including compasses and scissors) into the venue. They will be confiscated by security, and you may not be able to retrieve them.**

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

- **Is there anywhere I can store my coat and bags?**

Unfortunately, cloakrooms are not available for visitors at our events, we advise visitors to avoid bringing large bags and rucksacks into the event.

- **What insurance is in place for the event?**

The organiser has adequate public and employee liability cover. While the organisers take every precaution to protect visitors' property during an event, they are not responsible for any loss or damage. All group leaders should ensure they have adequate public and employers' liability cover, in line with the booking terms and conditions.

- **What happens to any lost property?**

All property found in the hall and handed to the Organisers Office, will be passed to the venue and kept for 14 days. After 14 days, if no claim in respect of that property has been made by any person, venue staff shall consider the property to be abandoned and has the right to dispose of it.

- **Can I smoke/vape on site?**

ICC Wales operates a strict no smoking policy in the venue and would ask for your full cooperation in ensuring this is complied with. This includes e-cigarettes.

- **What security is there?**

Security is present at the event throughout. If you are a victim of theft, please report it to the organiser's office immediately.
