# Using our systems



## There are several key systems that you'll need to use as UCAS Teacher Training providers:

#### web-link

Use the web-link button on the providers' page: www.ucas.com/members-providers. Choose the Application data button and log in to:

- Access applicant information
- Manage applications
- View applications
- Record decisions

#### Net.update

Use the web-link button on the providers page: www.ucas.com/members-providers to link to Net.update. Choose the institution data button and log in to:

- Set up other users for web-link and Net.update<sup>1</sup>
- Set up and manage training provider information and training programmes<sup>2</sup>
- Close training programmes
- Reopen training programmes for late vacancies
- Maintain training programme vacancy status and for discontinuing training programmes
